## More WREGIS Workshops

Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System (WREGIS) staff held the first in a series of three workshops on March 20 and 21, giving participants two opportunities for a general overview of WREGIS. The approximately one-hour workshop was offered on two consecutive days to better accommodate stakeholders' schedules, and time was provided for Questions and Answers at the end of each session. The final two workshops, each of which will also be held twice to allow for more stakeholder participation, have been organized to better prepare stakeholders for the launch of the system in June. These workshops will focus on the following WREGIS participant categories: (i) **Reporting Entities**, held on April 16 and 17 and (ii) **State/Provincial and Voluntary Program Administrators**, held on April 18 and 19. All workshops will be open to any interested parties.

The Reporting Entity workshop will provide information to anyone who may report generation data to WREGIS as well as to generator owners and agents who will need to have their generation reported. This webinar will be most useful for any entities that wish to become Qualified Reporting Entities in WREGIS.

The third and final webinar will provide information on how State/Provincial and Voluntary Program Administrators can participate in WREGIS and what generators can do to demonstrate eligibility for a
