



WREGIS Committee 2012 Election Schedule and Rules

January 2012

The WREGIS Committeeⁱ elections will be held on March 25-30, 2012 with the polls closing at 5:00pm Mountain Time.

The voting members of the Stakeholder Advisory Committee (SAC) will vote to fill the following seats on the WREGIS Committeeⁱⁱ:

- Load-Serving Entity
- Generating Unit owner
- Industry- Other
- State / Provincial Representative

Election Schedule

January 11	60 day posted
March 12 – 16	Nomination Period
March 23	Candidate Statements due and posted
March 26 – 30	Election conducted electronically under WECC procedures
April 11	Run-Off Election – if needed
May 4	Final Results to WECC
June 25-27	WECC Board Approval

Election Rules

- Only voting members of the Stakeholder Advisory Committee may cast ballots.
- Voting will take place via email.
- Each voting entity in the Industry Participant class may cast one vote for a representative of its Industry Participant sub-class (Generator sub-class or Load-Serving Entity sub-class).
- For Industry members, if multiple affiliates from the same entity are registered, it is their responsibility to identify and inform the SAC registrar of a single representative who will have the voting rights for that entity. Dispute resolution is the sole responsibility of the affiliates involved. If a single representative is not named, only the first vote cast by a representative from that entity will be counted, and the others will be discarded.



- A representative is elected by a majority of the votes cast for that class or sub-class. If no nominee within a class or sub-class receives a majority of the votes, there will be a run-off election on April 11th between the candidates who received the most votes on March 30, 2011.
