<b>Title:</b> PCR 174-Revisions to aggregate meter allocations and mixed fuel allocations		<b>Target date: Please explain ASAP</b>				
<b>Description:</b> The Operating Rules state, "The Account Holder will need to determine the split of generation (in percent terms) to each [aggregated multiple] Generating Unit and <b>may update this split as needed.</b> " This capability, however, does not exist in WREGIS to revise the allocation once the Certificates are created.						
<b>Rational/Benefit/Need:</b> It is possible that data needs to be revised for the aggregated meters and mixed fuel units after the QRE uploads the data to WREGIS and Certificates are created. Users should be allowed to revise the aggregate meter and mixed fuel allocations for two years after the Certificate creation date to ensure the most accurate data is available in WREGIS.						
<b>Consequences of not Implementing Change:</b> Certificates are created from inaccurate allocation data. For mixed fuel resources, the restriction to revise the multi-fuel allocations could result in Certificate creation from non-renewable generation.
