Description:

SMUD is a publicly owned utility (POU) and falls under the requirements of California's AB-32 legislation for the Renewable Energy Standard (RES). The details of the REC is being finalized. WREGIS RECs have been chosen for the compliance mechanism for the RES. The year 2010 is an important year for the REC (and also for the State RPS). SMUD has much of it's RES portfolio in WREGIS but not all. SMUD may not be the only POU in this situation. SMUD requests to be able to have REC retroactive created similiar to the request from Oregon.

The RES has chosen WREGIS RECs as its compliance mechanism. SMUD and other POU's will need to comply with the RES. SMUD needs to have retro RECs generated.

Consequences of Not Implementing Change:
